Program Objectives & Strategy

- Increase access to medicines and supplies in low resource countries
- Provide high-quality medicines and medical supplies to under resourced communities free of charge
- Strengthen health systems
- Maintain best practices in supply chain management and compliance to remain a trusted partner with donors and beneficiaries



Program Overview



Medicines and medical supplies selected from product offered by manufacturers and distributors (expiry < 12 months)



Supports medical mission teams, individual facilities, NGOs with health facility networks



Prescription medications, OTC products, vitamins, basic medical supplies, kits, reading glasses (non-prescription), some PPE



No equipment or diagnostics

Vitamins & Minerals

- *Prenatal Multi-nutrient Supplements, Childrens vitamins*

Cardiovascular Drugs

- *Antianginals, Antiarrhythmic, Antidiabetics, Antihypertensives, Antilipemic, Diuretics*

Medical Supplies

- *Syringes, Needles, Gowns, I.V Sets, Masks, Gloves*

Central Nervous System Drugs

- *Anticonvulsants, Antidepressants, Antipsychotics, Anxiolytics, Anti-inflammatory*

Respiratory Tract Drugs

- *Anticholinergics, Antihistamines, Bronchodilators, Corticosteroids*

Hormonal Drugs

- *Estrogens progestins, Steroidal anti-inflammatories, Thyroid hormones*

- *Antidiarrheal (Symptomatic), Antiemetic Drugs, Antiglycative and reflux drugs*

Partnership Considerations

1. The donee must be eligible for tax exempt donations. If it is a US donee, they must have 501c3 status or the equivalent if it is in another country.
2. CMMB does not cover the cost of shipping. The recipient is responsible for this cost.
We encourage you to reach out even if this is a barrier.
3. The recipient must be able to coordinate (duty-free) customs clearance for your donation shipment. Prior experience with medical imports and customs clearance is strongly preferred.



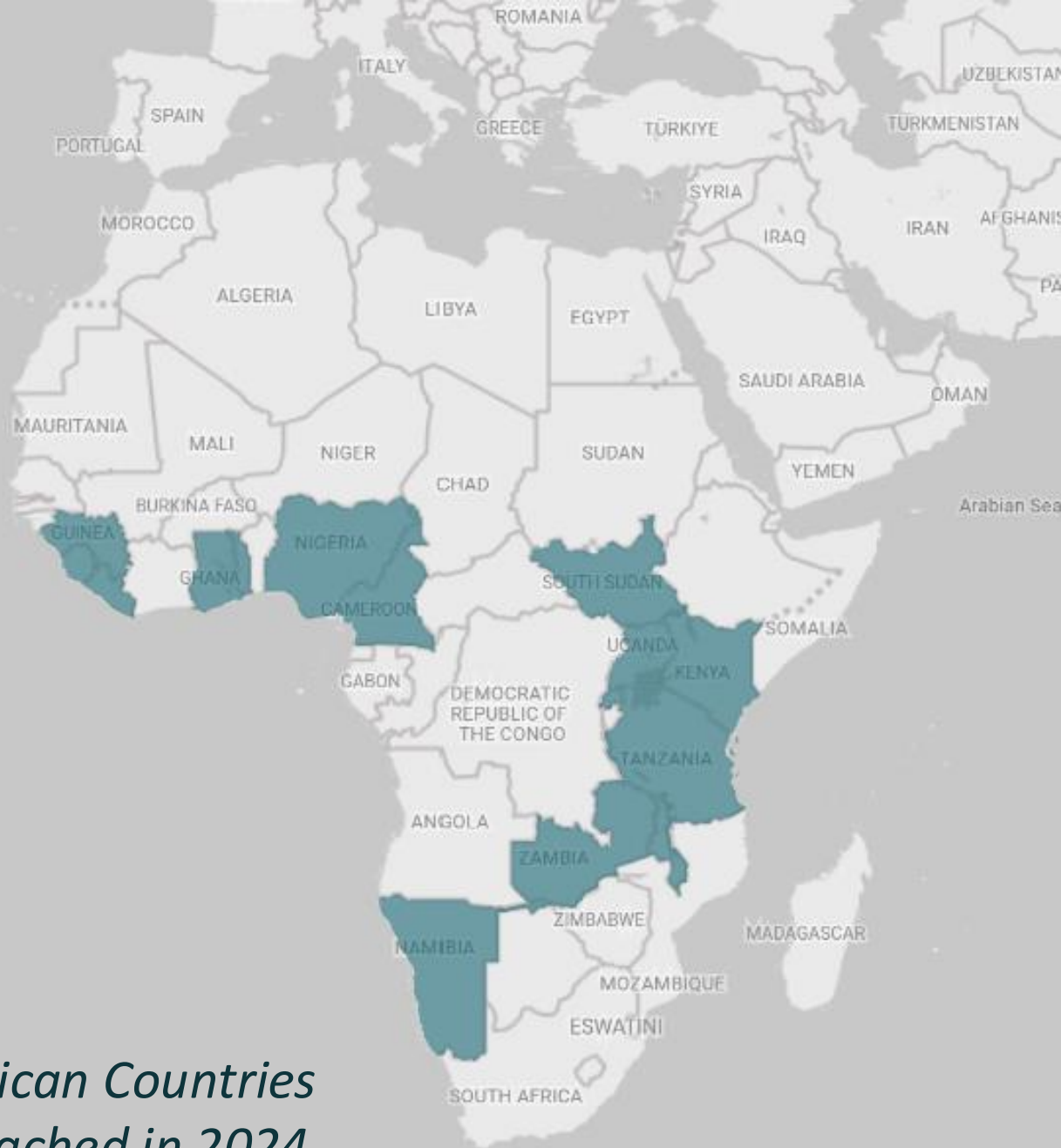
