

- 100% Linkage Rate to ART
- 100% Linkage rate of High Risk HIV Negative clients to Prevention Services



## **CHALLENGES**

- Point of Care CD4 Machine and Reagents
- Mortality cases are contributed by NCDs hence a need for drugs and reagents
- Decreasing of funds causes instability
- Poor social economic status of most of our clients-Nutrition
